

## **KISS EVENT**

(Keep It Simple Summer)

A KISS event is a fun scramble with members of clubs who belong to the Lee County 9-Hole Golf League. They're held between May and October.

The host club sends out a flyer with the details. We post it in our locker room, as well as in the 9-Hole League notebook in the pro shop, along with the sign-up sheet. When the "sign up by" deadline has passed, you will be notified and then asked for a check.

When you arrive at the host club, you'll check in at the registration table and will be told the hole you will be starting on. You'll look for the golf cart with the hole number posted. Your foursome will usually include a member of the host club and members of two other clubs.

Since there are typically no prizes at these events, you may not even be asked to keep score.

When your group is finished, you'll head to the dining room and sit together, along with another foursome.

Although the name says to keep it simple, sometime clubs will have a theme and ask you to dress in certain colors or outfits, which is optional.

## **INVITATIONALS**

Invitationals are like KISS events except scores are kept and prizes are awarded. They may also have raffle prizes.
